### **Questions SESSION 1:**

*A page from the life of the Prophet Ibrahim (as)*

1. Young people who changed the world; which Prophet is this session about?
2. Approximately when was he born?
3. What was the name of the King of the area (Babylon)?
4. Was our belief in Allah already in us when we were born?
5. Ibrahim knew he had a heart, and a soul placed inside him by Allah. What was his problem?
6. What did his father do?
7. What does it mean: to worship idols?
8. What did he ask his father and how did he ask him? Then how did his father respond?
9. Did Ibrahim give up? What did he do?
10. Was Ibrahim famous with the people? Was he famous with Allah?
11. How long did the people collect firewood?
12. The fire was so hot even ..... could not come near it (fill in the animal).
13. Ibrahim was scared, but his heart was attached to Allah. Which dua did he make? (Extra: write the dua in Arabic with the English meaning)
14. Nothing can harm you, not a person, a thing or even a virus without the permission of .... ? (fill in the blank)
15. Which two things did Allah say/order to the fire? (Bonus: write it in Arabic)
16. Why did Allah order the fire these two things, and not just one of them?

### **Some lessons to always remember:**

#### **1. You are never too small to make the world a better place!**

Ibrahim didn't say 'I'm just a little boy.' No matter how young you are, you can do great things.

With your belief in Allah and the Prophet and trust in Allah, you can achieve anything.

## **2. Trust your mind and your heart!**

Allah, subhanahu wa ta'ala, gave you a mind and heart. Allah placed all He loves in your heart, and all the things He doesn't like. Our hearts know what is good and what is best and Allah created us. If something feels wrong to you, it is wrong, so don't do it! Just because others do things, like listening to music or dancing, doesn't mean it's right. Always first ask yourself: Does Allah like this, what does Allah say about this? Only do it if Allah says yes, and don't do it if Allah says no. Even if the whole world does it!

## **3. When you teach people, speak nicely!**

Ibrahim asked his father gently. Whenever you teach someone something, do it in a nice, and gentle way. Some people don't know certain things, teach them kindly.

## **4. Use the dua: hasbiyallahu wa ni'mal wakeel!**

This means Allah is enough for me and He is the Best Protector. Whenever you are scared, overwhelmed or anxious, use this dua and put your trust in Allah that Allah will protect you.

## **5. Always remember nothing can harm you except with the permission of Allah!**

But also do everything to protect yourself. You trust Allah is in control of everything but you also try yourself and do everything you need to protect yourself and stay away from harm.

## **HOMEWORK:**

1. Learn the dua 'hasbiyallahu wa ni'mal wakeel'.
2. Make a list of wrong things many people do, but they are still wrong.

*Extra:* it is sunnah that when you love someone, because they are amazing Muslims, to tell them! Say to them: I love you for Allah's sake!
